# THE PRESIDENT AND CLUSTER MANAGER WORDS





Unfortunately, only with the ongoing health crisis the value of advanced textile materials arise.

To protect firefighters, at the operating theatre, in airplanes, in cars, to protect crops, to isolate buildings, to manufacture hotair balloons, to hold loads, to protect from the sun or to filter. These are advanced textile materials, where functionality is more important than aesthetics. They are everywhere and they are being manufactured in Catalonia.

# STRATEGIC PROJECTS

Coordinator of **GALACTICA – Smart Industrial innovation as enabler to drive new value chains for textiles and aerospace**, co-financed by the Horizon 2020 program (September 2020 - February 2023).

Objective: To facilitate the creation of new industrial value chains around the textile and aerospace industries based on advanced manufacturing.

It will open two calls for grants for companies, one in March 2021 and another in January 2022, with an overall budget of 2.8 million €. Selected projects will also receive support through coaching.





The project will also organize events to facilitate the generation of proposals and collaborations with other sectors involved including cross-sectoral missions to learn about the European aeronautics, aerospace and advanced manufacturing sectors, innovation workshops, webinars and hackathons involving students.

The project will offer travel grants in order to participate in European missions.




